### **WILLY TJUNGURRAYI**

Willy Tjungurrayi was born at Patjantja to the south-west of Lake MacDonald, circa 1930. He is the second of three brothers, one of which was Yala Yala Gibbs Tjungurrayi. Willy was living on the Western side of Lake MacDonald prior to walking in to Papunya with a large group. His first contact with Europeans was with one of Jeremy Long's welfare patrols near Lake MacDonald. In 1999 Willy contributed to the Kintore mens' painting as part of the Western Desert Dialysis Appeal.
